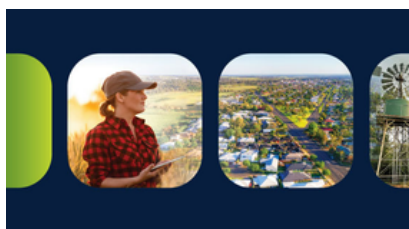


Business NSW – Riverina Murray

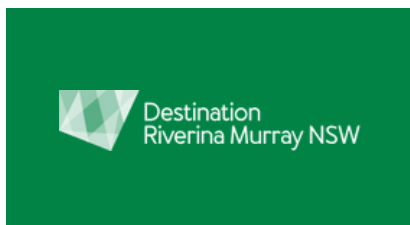


Jobs Riverina Murray

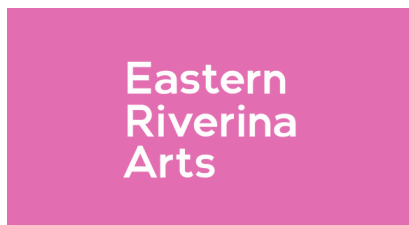


Destination Riverina Murray

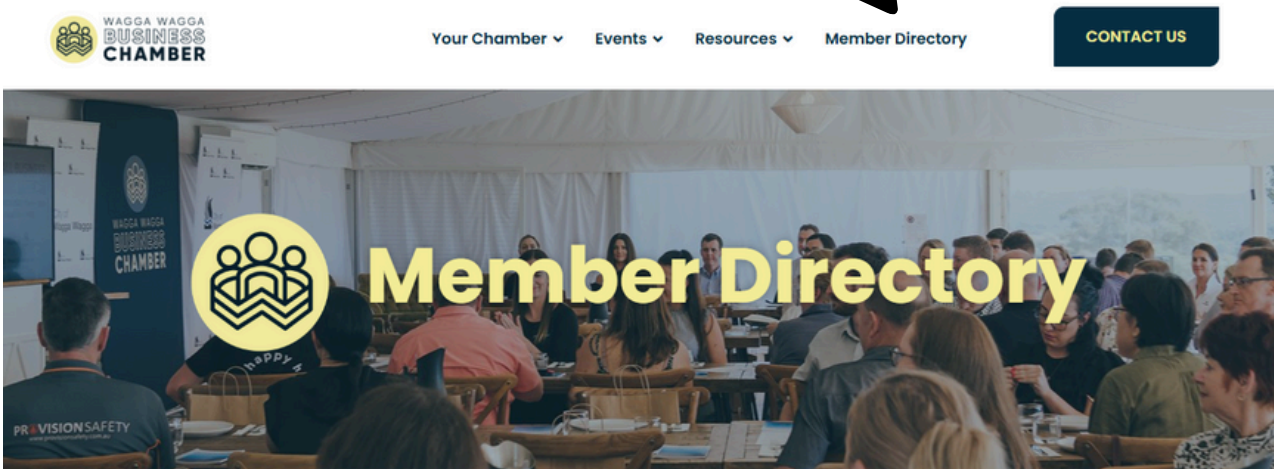


Riverina Community College
